End of May - Memorial Day Sunday!

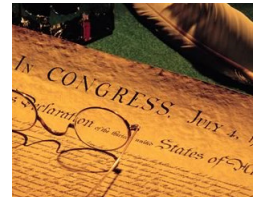
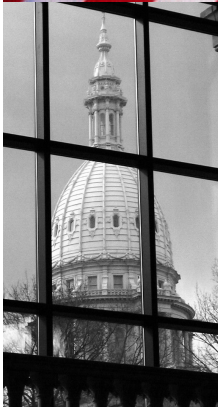
Remembering those Who have given their lives to protect the freedoms that we enjoy everyday, choose a Sunday close to May 30.
