Why Get Involved?

One of the best and most important ways to influence your community is to get involved in the government arena, starting at the local level.

Citizens often feel the only way to influence the process is to run for State Representative or Senator. But, that is not always the best place to start.

Anyone thinking about political office must have *experience, relationships, associations, and credibility*. Before someone elects you to represent them, voters want to know that you understand the issues and have experience at the local level.

Even if elected office is not your goal, you need to understand that many of the policies and ideas addressed at the state and national level, originate in your local communities.

And it is imperative that you remember those in office will advocate for what issues are important to them. If no one representing your belief system is in place, your issues will not be a part of the public conversation.

Make your *community* your area of expertise. Learn how to serve your local community. You'll meet new friends, as you seek to get better acquainted with what is really going on in your area and in the process, you will become a positive voice for conservative values.

My Government

County officeholders include: **Prosecutor, Sheriff, Clerk, Treasurer, Register of Deeds, and the Board of County Commissioners**

Townships In each of Michigan's 83 counties there are 6-16 Townships. Township Boards consist of a **Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer**, and two to four **Trustees**.

Villages & Cities Villages are organized under townships and cities are autonomous from the townships, therefore operations differ at times.

Villages and cities generally elect these offices: **Village Council Member or City Commissioner Mayor or Village President** (sometimes elected by the council members) **Treasurer and Clerk City or Village Managers** are appointed

Each of these local units of government also appoint several boards comprised of citizens. Some of these boards are required by state statute.

School Board Citizens also elect local **School Board members** (these are on a county or district basis, but separate from county government)

All of these positions are important to our local government and people who hold these positions often move up to higher office.
