CITIZENS FOR TRADITIONAL VALUES-PAC ENDORSEMENTS FOR MICHIGAN GOVERNOR

MICHIGAN – The Lansing based Citizens for Traditional Values Political Action Committee is proud to announce its endorsements for the Michigan Gubernatorial election. After careful scrutiny of the questionnaires and much deliberation the CTV-PAC Board chose three viable candidates whom they could support and work with once in office.

Mike Bouchard, Mike Cox and Pete Hoekstra all met the endorsement criteria for the 2010 Primary Election to be held on August 3, 2010.

CTV-PAC has been involved in Michigan politics since 1991, laboring to advance our guiding principles of *Faith and Family, Sanctity of Life, Proper Role of Government, and Excellence in Education*. Board Chairman Steve Jentzen said: *“We recognize the importance of this election for Michigan and encourage everyone to vote in the primary for the candidate who best represents their values.”*
