MI-SRA Council areas of focus are:

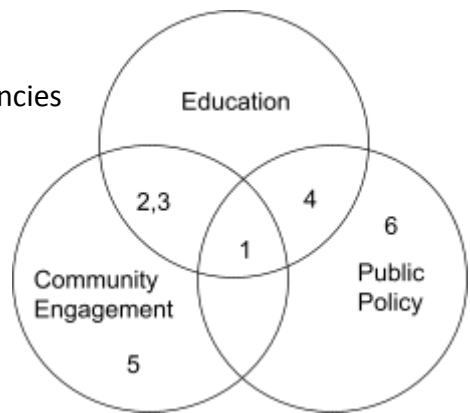
1. Increase SRAE in Public & Private Sectors
