

10 Reminders for School Year

1. **Know your local school district:** use www.michigan.gov/vote and find out what district you are paying taxes to. Get on their email lists, follow them on social media, and know what is taking place.
2. **Identify the school board members:** find their names, and contact information.
3. **Identify the regular board meeting times** and grab 3 friends to share the load of covering meetings. This gives you insight into the members, and issues – and the board sees you care!
4. **Identify who is running for your local school board** this year. Contact the best candidate and find out how you can help get them elected.
5. **Remind your friends:** parents' rights are paramount in the care and oversight of their children. **They should know about vaccine wavers, and their ability to remove their child from any content they do not want them to see. Use this resource here.**
6. **If your school offers Sex Education Curriculum,** contact the school to find out if they have a Sex Education Advisory Board committee as required by law. See the handouts for questions to ask.
7. **Ask to review the curriculum:** including Sex Education Curriculum, English Literature and Social science/history curriculum.
8. **What is the status of "groups" in your school:** Planned Parenthood, MOASH, trans-ideology focused groups, etc. Watch for mention of them in online posts, newsletters, or from school members.
9. **Prepare to rally around** a teacher or school administrator or student that you know in the system who is working to stand for truth: pray for them, offer to be support system
10. **Invite your church to join you** in regularly praying for your school - explore resources like www.momsinprayer.org
